Actions Taken by MPA:



- Promptly alerting the anchored vessels
- Advise the vessel to move and anchor at appropriate designated anchorages
- Issue navigational safety broadcast to alert all vessels using the TSS of vessels anchoring indiscriminately
- Requesting the flag administrations of the vessels to take appropriate action against the shipmaster for contravening international regulations

Information Provided to Cable Operators



 Information on vessels anchoring in, entering or leaving the location of the incident to identify the vessel responsible for the cable cut

 Details of the ship owners, agents and insurance companies i.e. P&I Club

Collaboration with Littoral States



- Worked with Littoral States, Indonesia and Malaysia to prepare IMO Circular to warn ships of anchoring on submarine cables
- Discussed at the recent 34 TTEG on draft IMO Circular
