Prestigious international conference on air transport, air law and regulation

NUS' Centre for International Law (CIL), McGill University's Institute of Air and Space Law (IASL) and the Singapore Aviation Academy (SAA) jointly organised the prestigious International Conference on Air Transport, Air Law and Regulation, held from 24 to 26 May 2010. The conference addressed critical issues facing civil aviation, with a particular emphasis on Asian air transportation.
