Hague Convention on Choice of Court Agreements (2005)

Aims of the Convention

- Exclusive choice of court agreements in favour of courts of Contracting States are effectively enforced
- Judgments rendered by the chosen courts are recognised and enforced in the other Contracting States

Benefits for Singapore

- Strengthens Singapore's position as a dispute resolution forum
- Contracting States obliged to recognise and enforce:
 - exclusive choice of court agreements that specify Singapore as forum
 - Singapore court judgments, including SICC judgements

Recent developments

- Currently 30 states are party to Convention
 - China signed Convention in September 2017
- **Harmonisation** of the recognition and enforcement of foreign judgment rules in Asia "not a pipe dream" (Adeline Chong, Asian Business Law Institute)

Civil Law (Amendment) Bill and Mediation Bill (2017)

Civil Law (Amendment) Bill

 Allows third-party funding to finance international commercial arbitration, in line with other major arbitration centres

Mediation Bill

- Inspired by UNCITRAL Model Law on International Commercial Conciliation
- Provides **statutory support** for international commercial mediation
 - Beefs up enforcement of mediated settlements

Both Bills bolster Singapore's position as a dispute resolution hub.

UN International Convention for the Suppression of Acts of Nuclear Terrorism (2005)

Aim of the Convention

• Prevent nuclear terrorism by criminalising related acts

Related developments in Singapore

- Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons (TPNW) (July 2017)
- Terrorism (Suppression of Misuse of Radioactive Material) Act (Aug 2017)
 - Mandatory death penalty imposed for fatal terrorist acts, including extra-territorial acts

Prevention on the Pollution of the Sea (Amendment) Bill (2017)

Background of the Bill

- International Convention for the Prevention of Pollution from Ships (1973) and related Protocol (1978)
- International Convention for the Control and Management of Ships' Ballast Water and Sediments (2004)
- Other marine environment protection agreements
 - e.g. Biodiversity Beyond National Jurisdiction

Recent developments in Singapore

- Prevention of Pollution of the Sea Act adopted in 1991
- 2017 amendments to the Act focus on managing ballast water and safe disposal of sediments
 - Increasing penalties for pollution
 - MPA empowered to make subsidiary legislation

Human rights treaty developments (2017)

Convention on the Rights of the Child (1989)

- Singapore's periodic report to Committee on the Rights of the Child
- · Benjamin Lim case
 - Launch of Appropriate Adult (AA) Scheme for minors

Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (1979)

- Singapore NGOs' first participation in CEDAW reporting cycle
- CEDAW held not relevant to housing for unwed moms
 - Parliamentary petition in September 2017

International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination

- Singapore ratified the Convention in Nov 2007
- Made reservations/declaration in relation to Art.2,6 & 22
- Public consultations on SG's first State Party Report in 2018
