## Judge Gilbert Guillaume

Judge Gilbert Guillaume was a Member of the International Court of Justice from 1987 to 2005, and the President of the Court from 2000 to 2003.

Judge Guillaume is an honorary member of the French Council of State, after having served as a Councillor of State. He was France's representative on the Legal Committee of the International Civil Aviation Organization and Chairman of that Committee from 1971 to 1975.

He was Chairman of the Conciliation Commission of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) and subsequently became the Director of Legal Affairs of that organisation. He served as the Director of Legal Affairs of the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs from 1978 to 1987, and as such, acted, among others, as the Agent of France before the Court of Justice of the European Communities and the European Court of Human Rights.

Judge Guillaume has served as judge ad hoc at the International Court of Justice on several occasions, as well as arbitrator in numerous disputes as a Member of the Permanent Court of Arbitration.

Judge Guillaume is a member of the Institut de France, of which he has been President, a member of the Institut de droit international, of which he has been Vice-President, and has published numerous works on a wide variety of topics in international law.

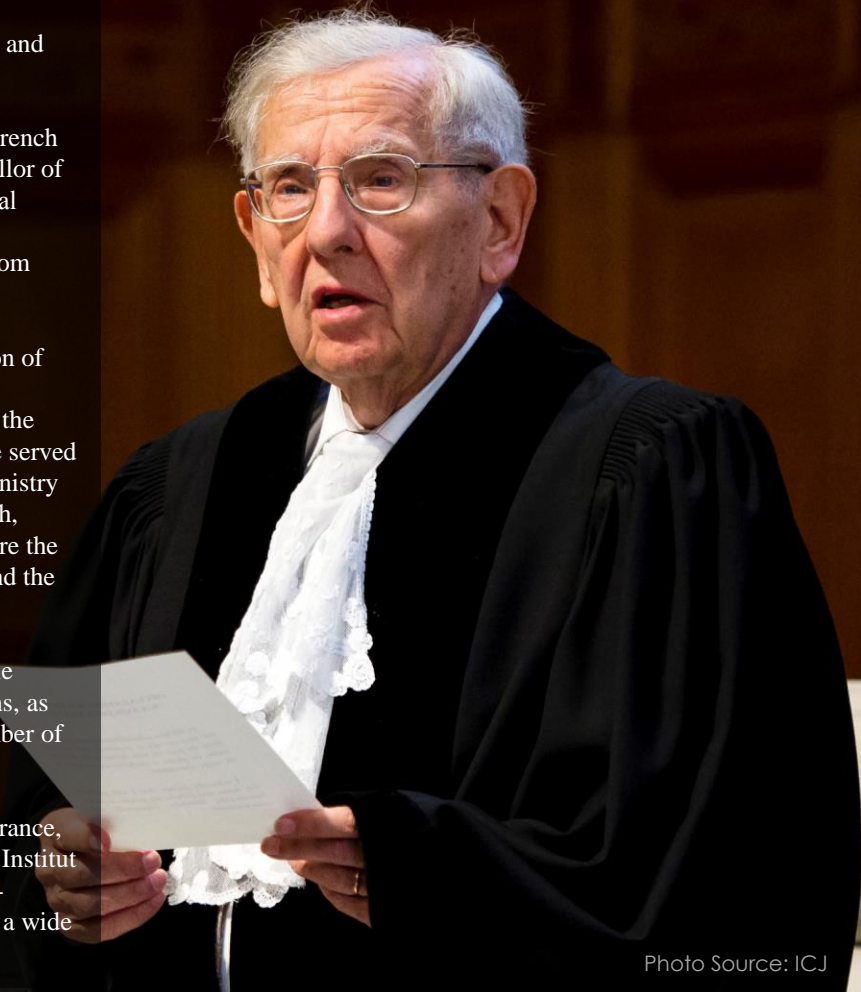
