

WANTED: Student Research Assistants

Two university-level research centres at the National University of Singapore (NUS), the Centre for International Law (CIL) and the NUS Energy Studies Institute (ESI), are in the final stage of a research project on nuclear law and policy that is part of the Singapore Government's Nuclear Policy Research Programme. The focus of the ESI-CIL Nuclear Governance Project is on two main research areas: international, regional and national legislative and regulatory frameworks for nuclear safety and security; and nuclear liability.

CIL is looking to hire Junior Research Assistants who would be able to work during the academic year and term break. NUS Law students as well as postgraduate students from other faculties with a legal academic background are welcome to apply. Successful applicants will be part of a multidisciplinary team working with researchers based at CIL and ESI.
