#### PHILIPPINES VS. CHINA

28 December 2013: PHL envoy to China: Seeking arbitration on sea row not an 'unfriendly act' In an email to GMA News Online, Basilio said the Philippine government decided to bring the sea dispute issue to international arbitration because "a rules-based regime in the West Philippine Sea and the South China Sea would contribute to the respect for the legitimate rights of countries surrounding the sea." "It would, over the long term, be beneficial to all stakeholders of the region, by providing the predictability and order necessary for continuing prosperity beyond our own generation," she added.

## 14 December 2013: Aquino pushes for peaceful means to resolve territorial disputes

"This approach is both peaceful and rules based," he said, calling for the adoption of a legally binding code of conduct "as soon as possible" and the use of arbitration to resolve territorial disputes. His use of the term arbitration was an allusion to the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea which provides for an arbitral tribunal to settle disputes between states. "In addition, arbitration promotes the rule of law and redounds to the benefit of all parties," Aguino said.

Again, China refused to participate in the proceedings... The Philippines will submit its Memorial by 30 March 2014," del Rosario said in a lecture held at the Ateneo de Manila University.

China's Ministry of Land and Resources (MLR) announced on Tuesday it had found a gas hydrate reserve that spans 55 square kms (34 square miles) in the Pearl River Mouth basin with controlled reserve equivalent to 100-150 billion cubic metres (bcm) natural gas. That would be the size of a major conventional natural gas field, like in China's top gas province Sichuan.

#### 17 December 2013: US Takes Aim at China, Ups Naval Aid to SE Asia

On his first visit to Vietnam as America's top diplomat, Kerry pledged an additional \$32.5 million for members of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations to protect their territorial waters and navigational freedom in the South China Sea, where four states have competing claims with China. Included in the new aid is up to \$18 million for Vietnam alone that will include five fast patrol-boats for its Coast Guard. With the new contribution, U.S. maritime security assistance to the region will exceed \$156 million over the next two years, he said.
