



Dr Sekimizu is Secretary-General Emeritus of International Maritime Organization(IMO); Chancellor Emeritus of World Maritime University(WMU); Special Advisor to the President of Kobe University, Japan; Adjunct Senior Fellow of Rajaratnam School of International Studies (RSIS) and Maritime and Port Authority (MPA) and Senior Advisor of MPA Academy, Singapore; and Honorary Chairman of the Consortium of International Maritime Heritage (CIMH).

He was born in 1952 in Yokohama, Japan and graduated from Osaka University in 1975 and worked for the Ministry of Transport of Japan until he joined IMO in 1989. He served IMO as Head of the Technology Section, Director of the Marine Environment Division and Director of the Maritime Safety Division and elected the Secretary-General of IMO in 2011. He served IMO from 2012 as the Secretary-General and retired from IMO at the end of 2015. After the retirement from IMO, he has been promoting academic studies on maritime governance of UN and the public awareness on maritime history and maritime heritages.

He was conferred various awards and medals from a number of countries and organizations including the International Maritime Prize for 2016 from IMO and honorary doctorates from various universities and academies including WMU. He is an Honorary Citizen of the City of Malmo, Sweden and holds the Key of Panama and received the Public Service Star (BBM) from the Government of Singapore in 2018.
