She was the President, and Chairperson of the Commission of the Whole, of the International Conference on Air Law which concluded the Montreal Protocol of 2014. She has also chaired other ICAO legal working groups.

She is currently the Chairperson of the ICAO Legal Committee and Vice-Chairperson of the ICAO Council's Commission of Experts of the Supervisory Authority of the International Registry (CESAIR).

She holds a LLB (Hons) from the University of Singapore and joined CAAS in 1998.
