



Dr. Túlio Di Giacomo Toledo is Legal Counsel and the current Representative of the Permanent Court of Arbitration (PCA) in the Republic of Singapore, assisting with the implementation of the PCA-Singapore Host Country Agreement and the promotion of PCA services in the region. He is the head of the PCA's office in Singapore and is regularly called upon to assist in the diplomatic work of the PCA with its Contracting Parties and other intergovernmental organizations.

As Legal Counsel, Dr. Toledo acts as registrar and tribunal secretary in international arbitrations involving various combinations of states, state entities, international organizations and private parties, including proceedings under investment treaties. He also assists the PCA Secretary-General with appointing authority matters, including challenges, under the UNCITRAL Arbitration Rules, domestic laws, and other procedural rules.

Dr. Toledo joined the PCA in 2015. He served as PCA Representative in the Republic of Mauritius from 2016 to 2019. Prior to joining the PCA, Dr. Toledo clerked at the International Court of Justice and worked as a practicing lawyer at a law firm in Brazil.

Dr. Toledo obtained a Ph.D degree as a Marie Curie Fellow from Bocconi University in Milan and an LL.M degree as a Thomas Buerghenthal Scholar from the George Washington University Law School, where he was awarded the Gruber Foundation International Law Fellow Award. In Brazil, he obtained bachelor's degrees in law and in international relations and a master's degree in law. In 2012, Dr. Toledo published a book on the foreign policy of the European Union. He is qualified to practice in Brazil.
