

Dr. Kraijakr Thiratayakinant

Dr. Kraijakr graduated LLB and LLM from Cambridge University, and PhD from London School of Economics and Political Science, specialising in international economic law.

At the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Thailand, he has participated in various negotiations of Thailand's free trade agreements (FTAs), including the Regional Comprehensive Economic Partnership (RCEP), ASEAN-Japan Economic Partnership (AJCEP), ASEAN-Australia-New Zealand FTA, ASEAN-Hong Kong FTA and ASEAN Comprehensive Investment Agreement (ACIA), as well as a number of Thailand's bilateral investment treaties (BITs). Dr. Kraijakr was posted at the Permanent Mission of Thailand to ASEAN between 2017-2020, handling issues related to the ASEAN Economic Community (AEC), ASEAN Connectivity, and acted as the Chair of the Working Group on ASEAN-India Dialogue Relations.

Dr. Kraijakr regularly acts as a guest lecturer for the Law Faculties of Thammasat University and Chulalongkorn University in the past 10 years in the areas of WTO law, international investment law, and ASEAN. He also publishes a textbook on WTO and Trade in Services and a number of academic articles as well as research papers on the AEC.

Currently, Dr. Kraijakr is the head of international agreement sub-division at the Department of International Economic Affairs, which is responsible for Thailand's policy on international investment protection.
