

HE DATO' DR AZFAR BIN MOHAMAD MUSTAFAR



Dr Azfar bin Mohamad Mustafar is the High Commissioner of Malaysia to Singapore. From September 2018 until May 2021, he served as the Ambassador of Malaysia to France, with concurrent accreditation to Monaco and Portugal. Prior to that, he was the Director General, Department of Maritime Affairs of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Malaysia. Dr Azfar joined the Malaysian civil service in 1996, and his past assignments include, amongst others, service as Programme Coordinator, Institute of Diplomacy and Foreign Relations, and as an Assistant Director, National Security Council, Prime Minister's Department.

Dr Azfar holds a BA (Hons.) in South East Asian Studies from the University of Malaya, an MSc in Maritime Affairs from the World Maritime University (WMU) Sweden, and a PhD in Maritime Law from the University of Wales Swansea under the WMU–UWS Joint Doctoral Programme.

Dr Azfar was conferred the *Darjah Indera Mahkota Pahang* (DIMP) award by the Sultan of Pahang in 2018. More recently, Dr Azfar was conferred the Outstanding Alumnus Award by WMU.
