Originally from South Africa, Jacqueline has accumulated a wealth of experience in law enforcement within the South African Police Service (SAPS) for the past 32 years. She has been appointed the Head of the Africa Cybercrime Operations Desk at the INTERPOL Cybercrime Directorate in Singapore as a seconded official from the South Africa Police Service. Under this mandate Jacqueline focused on joint cross-jurisdictional coordinated operations within the 49 Africa Member Countries. She has also been acting as the Assistant Director, Cyber Threat Response for INTERPOL for the past 6 months. Here she was responsible for coordinating Cyber Threat Intelligence with all 195 INTERPOL Member Countries globally to reduce the global impact of cybercrime and to protect communities for a safer world with the assistance of the INTERPOL Gateway Private Partners.

With over 32 years of law enforcement experience, she is a trained Hostage Negotiator, a Certified Fraud Examiner, Operational Tactical Trainer and an expert in the Intelligence and Operational Environment.

Previously Jacqueline held several management positions within the South African Police Service such as the Team Leader of the High Risk Reaction Unit, a Senior Special Investigator at the Directorate for Special Operations as well as recently the Head of the Financial and Cybercrime Intelligence Unit in South Africa.

Jacqueline has strong experience in the collection of intelligence and coordination and execution of operations with special reference to cybercrime threat intelligence. In this capacity, she also formed part of the South African Police Service Cybercrime Steering Committee responsible for developing the SAPS Cybercrime Strategy and Policy documents.
