Dr Przemysław Roguski is an Assistant Professor of Law at the Jagiellonian University in Kraków (Poland). His research focuses on the law of peacetime cyber operations and different aspects of international law relating to cybersecurity, ICT and internet governance. He is an Expert on cybersecurity at the Kościuszko Institute and a Senior Advisor at the ICT4Peace foundation, where he conducts workshops and masterclasses on cyber diplomacy and international law for diplomats and governmental employees, i.a. for the Organization of American States' cybersecurity program. Przemysław holds law degrees from the University of Mainz (Germany), Trinity College Dublin (Ireland) and a PhD in international law from Jagiellonian University.
