

Ms Daphne Hong is concurrently the Solicitor-General of the Attorney-General's Chambers of Singapore and the Director-General of its International Affairs Division (IAD). She is Singapore's Legal Adviser and heads IAD, the department that advises the Singapore government on all international law matters and represents Singapore in international negotiations and dispute

resolution.
