Professor Raphael J. Heffron is a Professor, Barrister-at-Law and Senior Counsel. He is also an international expert on climate change, sustainability and just transition public policy issues. He is a graduate of both Oxford (MSc-Christ Church) and Cambridge (MPhil-Darwin & PhD-Trinity Hall) Universities (UK). Currently Professor Heffron is Professor and Dean at the College of Law Abu Dhabu University in UAE (one of the World's Top-200 Universities ranked by the Times Higher Education).

The principal focus of his work is on achieving a sustainable and just transition to a low- carbon economy, and combines a mix of governance, management, law, policy and economics. A key theme behind his work is human rights and he has been appointed to a UN committee on the just transition as well as the UNESCO policy lab. His work has featured in the Top-2% Stanford-Elsevier Scientist List in 2020, 2022, 2023 and 2024. He has published over 200 publications of different types and is the most cited scholar in his field worldwide for energy and just transition law and public policy (6000+ Scopus/11,500+ Google Scholar) with translated work in multiple languages including Chinese, Italian, French, Spanish, Arabic and Persian. Professor Heffron has given over 220 keynotes/guest lectures in 68 countries.
