



Dr. Tleuzhan Zhunussova is a post-doctoral researcher at the Faculty of Law, University of Helsinki, and a member of the ERC-funded project *Intergovernmental Organizations Between Mission and Market (PRIVIGO)*, led by Jan Klabbers. Her current research examines private sector funding in international organizations and its implications for institutional autonomy, governance and legitimacy in global governance. She holds a Ph.D. in international law from the European University Institute and an LL.M from the University of Edinburgh. Prior to joining Helsinki, she was a post-doctoral fellow at NYU School of Law and the Sant'Anna School of Advanced Studies, and held visiting positions at various institutions, including the Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and International Law. At NUS, she will be focusing on advancing her book manuscript on private funding in the UN system (currently under contract with Cambridge University Press).
