



Gabrielle Marceau is a recently retired Senior Counsellor in the Research Division of the World Trade Organization (WTO) Secretariat and Honorary Professor at the Faculty of Law of the University of Geneva. She joined the GATT/WTO Secretariat in 1994 and, over more than thirty years, served in a number of legal roles, including Counsellor in the Legal Affairs Division, Legal Advisor in the Cabinet of Director General Pascal Lamy, Acting Director and Officer in Charge of the Legal Affairs Division, and Senior Counsellor in the Economic Research and Statistics Division. From 2004 to 2025 she was Associate Professor at the University of Geneva, and she has also served as President of the Society of International Economic Law. Professor Marceau has been a visiting professor at several universities around the world and has published extensively on WTO law and international economic law.
