Professor Alexander Proelss holds the Chair for the Law of the Sea and International Environmental Law, Public International Law and Public Law at the Faculty of Law of the University of Hamburg, where he also serves as the Director of the Institute for the Law of the Sea and Maritime Law (ISSR). His research centres on international environmental law and the law of the sea, while also extending to general international law, European Union law, and constitutional law. He is widely known as the editor of the *Commentary on the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea* (2017), a leading reference work in the field.

Alexander Proelss has co-led and contributed to numerous major national and international research initiatives and has served on three committees of the International Law Association. He has extensive experience advising State authorities, international organizations and private actors on issues of public international law. He has held visiting professorships at leading universities worldwide and regularly teaches and lectures at international conferences and academic programmes.
