



ASEAN SUSTAINABLE AVIATION ACTION PLAN (ASAAP)

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Section 1: Introduction

- The specific goals of 2016-2025 Kuala Lumpur Transport Strategic Plan (KLTSP) include, among others, identifying and implementing the key measures on sustainable transport, and intensifying regional cooperation in the development of sustainable transport related policies and strategies.
- In addition, given the increasing focus on sustainability by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and industry, the ASEAN Air Transport Working Group (ATWG) discussed and agreed to develop an ASEAN Sustainable Aviation Action Plan (ASAAP) during the 45th ATWG Meeting held on 25-27 April 2022 in Singapore.
- The 46th ATWG, 12-15 September 2022, further agreed for Singapore, as the lead country, to develop the work plan for ASAAP, by working closely with the team members from ASEAN Member States. ASEAN Member States have nominated their relevant experts / Points of Contact (POCs).
- The 54th ASEAN Senior Transport Officials Meeting (STOM), and 28th ASEAN Transport Ministers (ATM) Meeting held in October 2022 in Bali, Indonesia, supported the development ASAAP and its work plan. The Ministers further endorsed “the Adoption of the ASEAN Sustainable Aviation Action Plan (ASAAP) and its Work Plan” as one of the annual priorities / key deliverables in transport for 2023.
- The Terms of Reference (TOR) for ASEAN Sustainable Aviation Action Plan has been adopted by the ATWG on ad referendum basis.

Section 2: Purpose

- The ASAAP seeks to drive sustainable aviation growth in ASEAN, starting from the area of sustainable aviation fuels, and aims to:
 - ✓ share best practices on aviation decarbonisation to support capacity building.
 - ✓ facilitate information exchange to advance the region’s aviation sustainability and decarbonisation efforts.
 - ✓ collaborate among ASEAN Member States, dialogue partners and experts to develop an ASEAN Sustainable Aviation Roadmap.
 - ✓ support the efforts and objectives on sustainable transport under the Kuala Lumpur Transport Strategic Plan 2016-2025 and the subsequent Post-2025 Vision Roadmap for ASEAN Transport Cooperation.
